

## MACU ALEKS PPL – Fall 2025 or Spring 2026 Student Registration Instructions

Follow the steps below to register for and access ALEKS Placement Prep & Learning, PPL. For help with registration, contact ALEKS Customer Support (800-258-2374; [support.aleks.com](https://support.aleks.com)). You will need the following information to register:

- 1) Your student ID number
- 2) Your MACU email address
- 3) A credit/debit card to pay \$25 fee

**Step 1:** Visit [www.aleks.com](https://www.aleks.com) and select **SIGN UP NOW!**

**DQPR3-6W6XF (Fall 2025) or AT9GM-9DRKV (Spring 2026)** into the Course Code box.

Then select **Continue**.

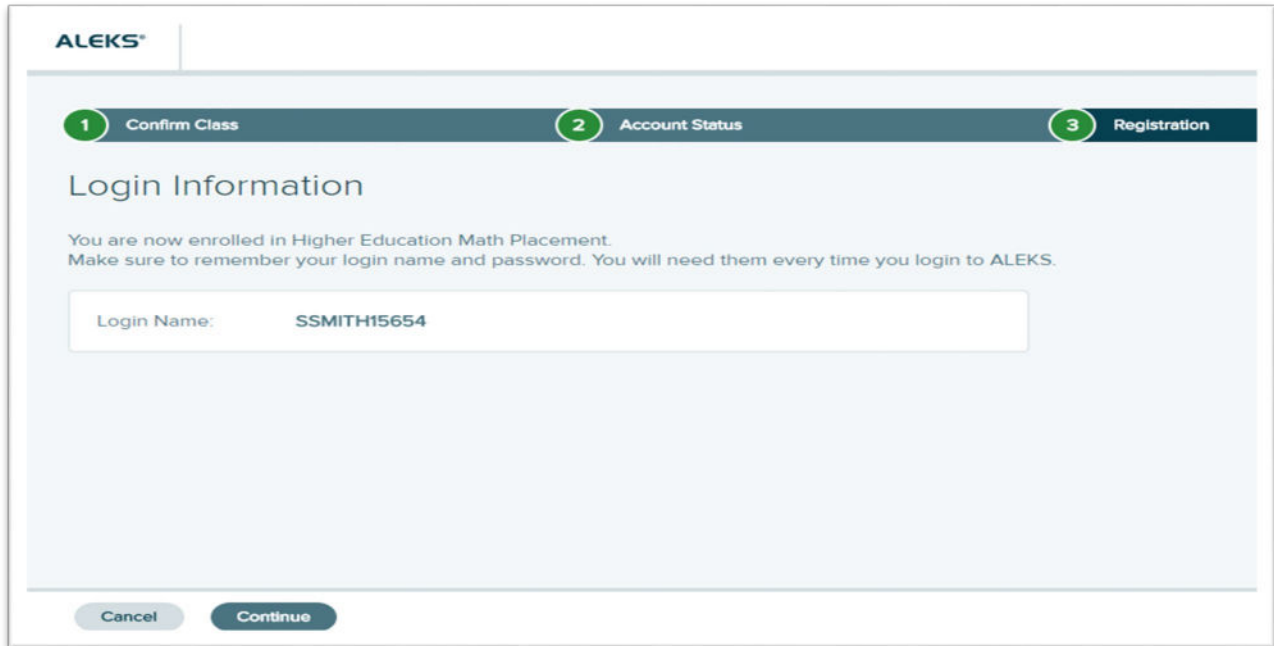

**Step 3:** Verify Your Cohort.

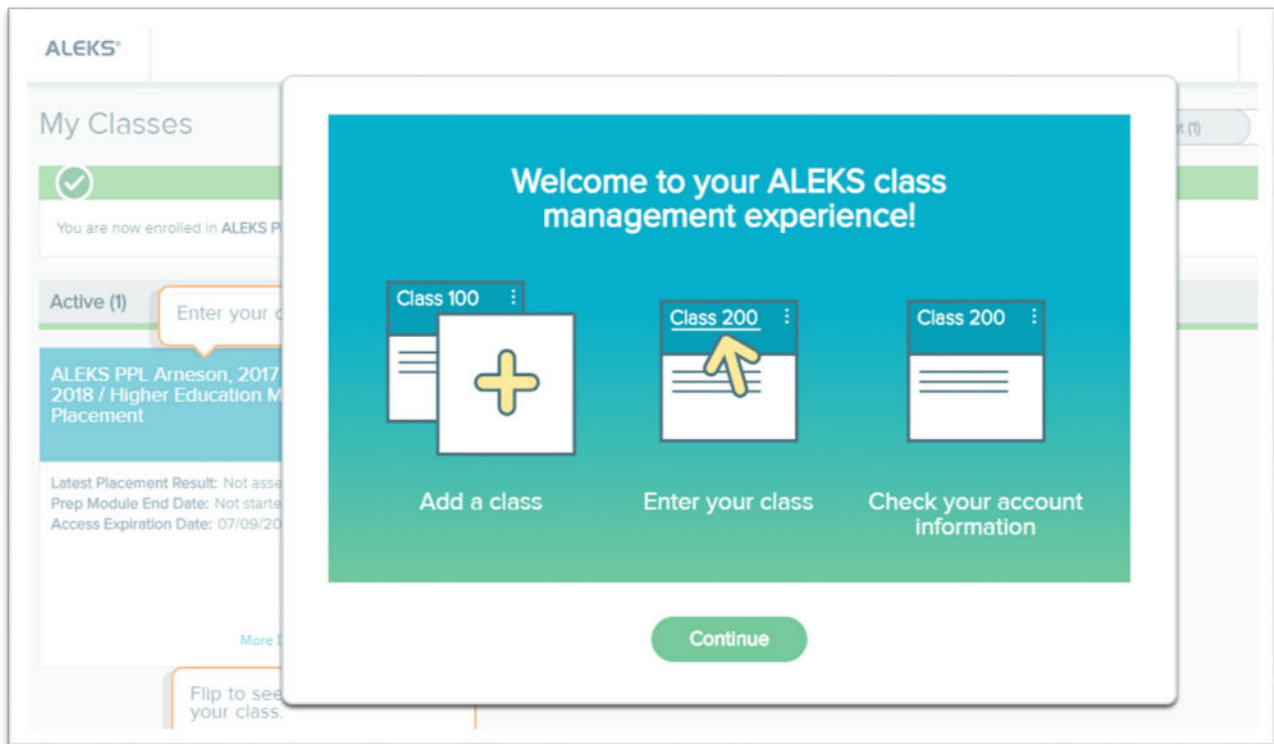
**Step 4:** Select “No, I have never used ALEKS before.” Then select **Continue**.

**Step 5:** Complete the Student Information and be sure to write down the password you create. Agree to the **Terms of Use** and then select **Continue**.

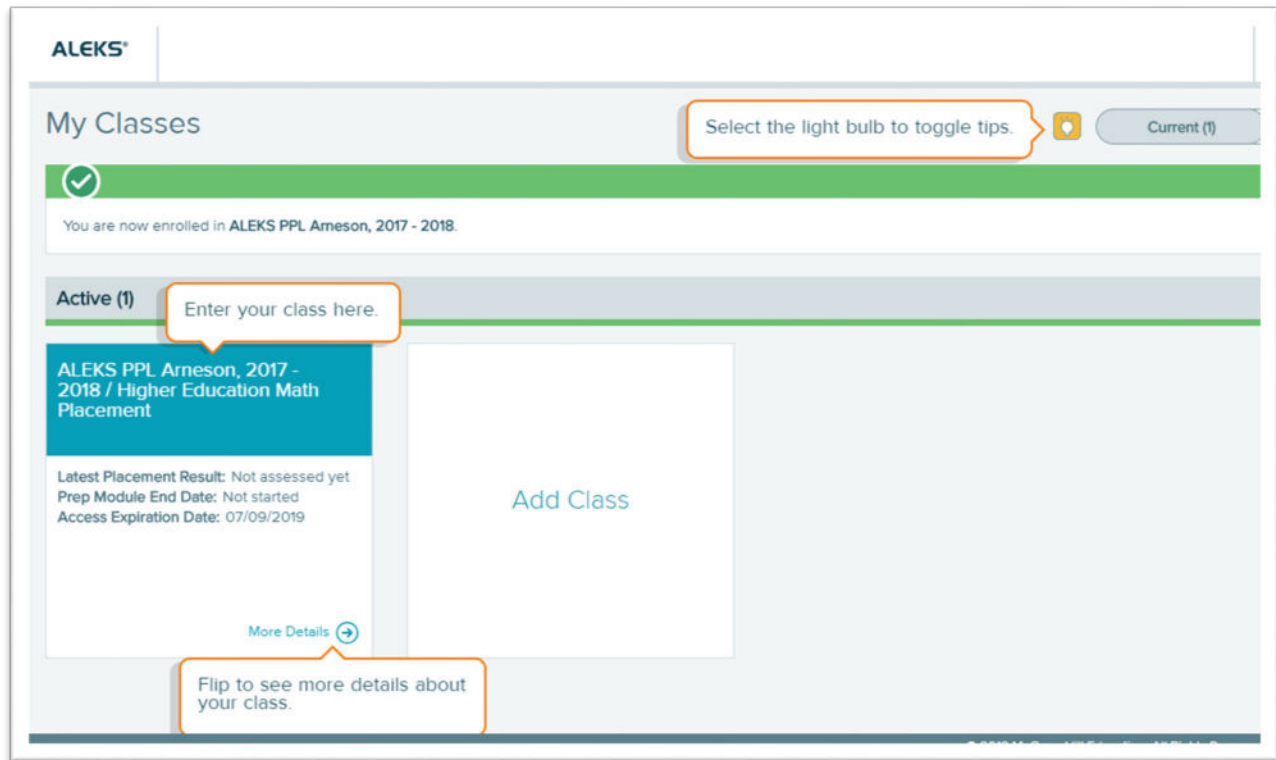
