GPA 3.9+ **AND** SAT/ ACT/ CLT 1320+/ 29+/ 104+: **Full Tuition**

Qualifications:

- Acceptance to Mid-Atlantic Christian University (MACU)
- Limited to 4 consecutive years (8 consecutive semesters), maximum of 18 credit hours per semester
- **Current high school applicant:** Awarded based on completed coursework/unweighted GPA (mid-year) and/or SAT/ACT/CLT scores.
- **Previously graduated high school applicant:** Awarded based on official unweighted high school GPA.
- **College transfer students (minimum of 12 earned, transferable college credits) with no SAT/ACT/CLT scores:** Awarded based on cumulative college GPA.
- Must be degree-seeking.
- Must submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Requirements:

- **Full Tuition Scholarships:** must maintain a cumulative 3.3 GPA.
- **All other Merit Scholarships:** must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA.
- Must live in the dorm and be on the University meal plan
- Must be enrolled full time (at least 12 credit hours) each semester
- Awarded yearly with scholarship eligibility checked at the end of each semester.

Deadlines:

- Limited number of scholarships awarded on a rolling deadline of December 1 thru March 1
- **March 1st:** Applicants must be fully accepted to the University
- **March 15th:** Final scholarship award date
- **March 30th:** Scholarship acceptance deadline **and** \$250 confirmation fee (applied towards housing)
- **April 15th:** Re-award date for any declined awards
- **April 30th:** Scholarship acceptance deadline **and** \$250 confirmation fee (applied towards housing)

Please Note:

- We accept super scores for SAT, ACT, and CLT tests.
- There are a limited number of scholarships offered at the sole discretion of the University.
- Those applying are strongly encouraged to have an on-campus visit.
- To receive the full award amount, the recipient must complete the semester. If the recipient withdraws from college prior to the end of the semester, this scholarship award will be prorated for that semester.
- This is a stackable scholarship.
