Qualifications:

- Acceptance to Mid-Atlantic Christian University (MACU)
- Limited to 4 consecutive years (8 consecutive semesters)
- **Current high school applicant:** Awarded based on completed coursework/unweighted GPA (mid-year) and/or SAT/ACT/CLT scores.
- **Previously graduated high school applicant:** Awarded based on official unweighted high school GPA.
- **College transfer students (minimum of 24 earned, transferable college credits):** Awarded based on cumulative college GPA. Transfer students with less than 24 transferable hours will use their high school GPA.
- Strongly encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Requirements:

- **Full Tuition Scholarships:** must maintain a 3.5 semester and/or cumulative GPA.
- **All other Merit Scholarships:** must maintain a 3.0 semester and/or cumulative GPA.
- Must live in the dorm and be on the University meal plan
- Must be enrolled full time each semester in a degree seeking program of study
- Scholarship eligibility checked at the end of each semester.

Deadlines:

- Limited number of scholarships awarded on a rolling deadline of December 1 thru May 1
- Acceptance of the scholarship is due within three (3) weeks after the offer is made.

Please Note:

- We accept super scores for SAT, ACT, and CLT tests.
- There are a limited number of scholarships offered at the sole discretion of the University.
- Those applying are strongly encouraged to have an on-campus visit.
- To receive the full award amount, the recipient must complete the semester. If the recipient withdraws from college prior to the end of the semester, this scholarship award will be prorated for that semester.
- This is a stackable scholarship.
