



Luke 2:52 Scholarship 2023-2024

Amount:

- \$60,000+ disbursed over 4 years- awarded for 8 consecutive semesters
- Half Tuition under the block tuition format

Qualifications:

- Acceptance to Mid-Atlantic Christian University (MACU)
- **High School Students:** Must have an incoming minimum unweighted GPA of 2.75
- **Transfer Students (24+ credit hours):** Must have an incoming minimum college GPA of 2.75
- Submit two letters of recommendation stating applicant's specific outstanding achievements (ex.: awards or special recognition) in his/her spiritual life as well as physical, mental, **and** social life. **Acceptable references include:** teachers, counselor, minister, coach, or employer- Letters CANNOT be from persons related to the applicant.
- Must submit a 500-700 word essay that clearly states student's potential and drive to shine for Christ at MACU, in the Church, and in society.
- Strongly encouraged to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled full time each semester in a degree seeking program
- Maintain a 2.75 semester GPA (1st semester) and 3.0 semester and/or cumulative GPA for all remaining semesters while attending MACU
- Must live in university housing and be on the meal plan
- Must volunteer to work on-campus 60 hours per semester (about 3 hours each week) to maintain scholarship eligibility
- Scholarship eligibility checked at the end of each semester

Deadlines:

- **April 1st:** Applicants must be fully accepted to the University and Scholarship Application (two letters of recommendation and essay) must be submitted
- **April 15th:** Scholarship award date
- Acceptance of the scholarship is due within three (3) weeks after the offer is made.

Please Note:

- There are a limited number of scholarships offered at the sole discretion of the University.
- Those applying are strongly encouraged to have an on-campus visit.
- To receive the full award amount, the recipient must complete the semester. If the recipient withdraws from college prior to the end of the semester, this scholarship award will be prorated for that semester.
- This is a non-stackable scholarship.
