



## **Mid-Atlantic Christian University Announcement for Full-Time Faculty Position**

### **Biblical Studies Professor (Rank Open)**

#### **Position Description:**

This is a full-time faculty position, beginning January 1, 2022 or July 1, 2022 (preference is January 1). Salary is commensurate with experience and degree held at the time of appointment. The faculty member will develop and teach undergraduate level courses, evaluate instructional outcomes of assigned courses, and evaluate program level student learning outcomes. The faculty member will attend committee and faculty meetings, and maintain regular office hours. Full-time faculty are expected to pursue professional development as appropriate to the field of biblical studies, and be involved in church and community service opportunities.

The ideal candidate will be able to teach courses from both testaments, course on how to interpret Scripture, and at least one biblical language.

#### **Qualifications:**

The applicant must be experientially and theologically committed to the Stone-Campbell (Restoration Movement) faith tradition, and in full agreement with the school's doctrinal statement.

Preferred applicants will have an earned terminal degree (e.g., Ph.D. or Th.D.) in biblical studies (Old or New Testament). Candidates with a Masters degree (e.g., M.A. or M.Div.) in biblical studies will be considered, and if hired will be expected to begin doctoral studies immediately and finish the doctoral program (Ph.D. or Th.D) in a reasonable window of time.

The candidate must possess a mature Christian faith and be able to demonstrate teaching competence, scholarly ability and be knowledgeable in his or her discipline.

Experience teaching online would be a plus.

#### **Responsibilities:**

One must be able to contribute to the well being and advancement of an academic Christian community by integrating scholarship with the community's faith tradition. The candidate must be a person of virtuous character and lifestyle who is willing to invest himself or herself in the holistic development of his or her students. The candidate must be committed to both ministerial and discipleship training in a Christian university context.

#### **Application Process:**

Send (1) a letter of application, (2) a curriculum vitae, (3) unofficial copies of all undergraduate and graduate transcripts, (4) a list of four references (three professional and one spiritual) whom the university may contact, and (5) a statement of teaching philosophy that includes how the applicant has integrated or intends to integrate a Christian Theistic Worldview in the teaching-learning process.
