Announcement for Full-Time Staff Position

Residence Hall Director

Position Overview:

Reporting to the Vice President for Student Services (VPSS), the Residence Hall Director's (RHD) primary purpose at Mid-Atlantic Christian University is to develop relationships to enhance further the academic, social, and spiritual development of students living within an assigned residence hall, either Pearl A. Presley Hall or Harold C. Turner Hall. This is accomplished by, but not limited to, overseeing Resident Assistants (RAs), interacting with students within assigned residence hall to increase retention, managing the needs of the physical building, and assisting with additional Student Life functions.

Essential Responsibilities:

- A. Act as a college representative in all aspects of life.
 - a. Pray for students.
 - b. Provide an example of Christian character and personal growth.
 - c. Encourage students in their development of Christian character.
 - d. Provide guidance and counsel to residential and commuter students.
 - e. Respond to students' concerns and requests, referring students for professional and/or Biblical counseling as needed.
 - f. Communicate and enforce dorm rules and submit incident reports when necessary.
- B. Manage RAs
 - a. Meet with RAs weekly as a group in the assigned residence hall.
 - b. Meet with RAs bi-weekly (every other week) individually.
 - c. Assist in RA selection and training.
- C. Retention Strategies
 - a. Interact with residents through hall meetings, dorm-specific programs, and more.
 - b. Communicate any student concerns to VPSS as they arise or are learned of.
- D. Building Management
 - a. Maintain an accurate list of who lives in each room within the assigned residence hall.
 - b. Assist in distributing and collecting room keys at the beginning and end of each semester.

- c. Schedule monthly health and safety inspections of rooms to be conducted by RAs.
- d. Conduct monthly inspections of the residence hall.
- e. Submit support tickets and communicate any concerns to VPSS as they arise.
- f. Assist with fire and emergency drills.

Qualifications:

1. A heart committed to ministering to students of varying ages and ethnicities.
2. The ability to be a team player that works well with and networks with faculty, staff, students, and the community.
3. Active membership in the Christian Church, Church of Christ, or spiritually compatible denomination is required.
4. A Bachelor's Degree is preferred; a plan for continued growth and education is expected.
5. The ability to use Google Sheets, Google Docs, Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel is required.
6. Ability to complete tasks in a timely fashion.

Position Details:

- Being available most evenings, including weekends, per week is required.

Compensation and Benefits:

- Housing is provided in a 3-bedroom on-campus apartment.
- Up to 240 total meals in the cafeteria per semester for the RHD and his immediate family
- Dependent scholarships
